



HISTORY

The site of The Dylan dates back to the year 1613, when construction workers began excavating the Keizersgracht canal. Five years later a theatre was founded in the building, named the Duytsche Academie.

On the 100th anniversary of the theatre, in the year 1737, it was Antonio Vivaldi himself who conducted the theatre's orchestra. The theatre also gave birth to the longest running theatre tradition in the world to date, the Gijsbreght van Aemstel. This Dutch version of the Trojan Horse story marks the end of medieval Amsterdam and preludes the Dutch Golden Age in the 17th century. It is traditionally played in the first week of each New Year, until the early 70s due to a lack of subsidy. In 2018 it was brought back to life in its première location by The Dylan, almost 4 centuries after the first performance.

The building caught fire in 1772 and burned down. Only the present Van Campen's doorway (current main entrance gate) was spared and reminds us today of the location's rich history. In 1773 the site was sold to one of the Regents of the Roman Catholic Church charities, known as the Old & Poor People's office and was turned into a hotel in 1999.




